**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
ROSALIE STLUKA
AND THE
OHIO STATE COUNSELOR AND SOCIAL WORKER BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into and between ROSALIE STLUKA, hereinafter, "STLUKA", and the OHIO STATE COUNSELOR AND SOCIAL WORKER BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD", the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated thereunder.

STLUKA hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the BOARD or any of its members, employees or agents.

STLUKA is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. STLUKA is an Independent Social Worker (I-2763) licensed to practice social work in the state of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of social work as outlined in O.R.C. Chapter 4757.
2. From January 1996 to May 1997, STLUKA was the work supervisor for Person #1, while Person #1 was an employee of the AIDS Task Force Regional Cooperative, Inc., in Lima, Ohio. Person #1 was the social worker for the agency and as such needed an Independent Social Worker to supervise her.
3. Between October 1996 and May 1997, STLUKA, as Person #1's work supervisor, did not sign off on supervisee reports for individual clients and did not review all the client files for clients under the care of Person #1. This is in violation of O.R.C. 4757.13(A) (O.R.C. 4757.36(A)(1) as of 3/18/97) and O.A.C. 4757-17-02.
4. STLUKA ADMITS the facts referenced in paragraphs 1 through 3 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, **STLUKA** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

- A. **STLUKA** is **REPRIMANDED** by the **BOARD**
- B. **STLUKA** agrees in the future to fully comply with O.A.C. 4757-17-02, (O.A.C. 4757-23-01 as of 7/3/97). Failure to do so could result in further disciplinary action.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this **AGREEMENT**, **STLUKA** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **STLUKA** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

STLUKA hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** into a formal journal entry at its March, 1998, meeting.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall take effect upon the date of the last signature below:
