**CONSENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
TERRY L. WINES  
AND THE  
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND  
FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between TERRY L. WINES, hereinafter, "**WINES**," and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "**BOARD**," the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

**WINES** hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the **BOARD** or any of its members, employees or agents.

**WINES** is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should **WINES** fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **WINES** knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. **WINES** is a social worker (S-28493) licensed to practice social work in the State of Ohio, and is subject to the laws and rules of Ohio regulating the practice of social work as outlined in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4757 and Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4757. **WINES** received her social work license on March 16, 2001.
2. From on or about winter 2002 to about spring 2003, while **WINES** was employed as a social work associate at the Veteran's Administration, Columbus, Ohio, she blurred her professional

boundaries by giving haircuts to clients, which was not part of her job duties. Her conduct constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01C(1).

3. Between about late Fall 2002 and about early winter 2002 while **WINES** was employed as a social work associate at the Veteran's Administration, Columbus, Ohio, she blurred her professional boundaries by allowing a client to hug her and to kiss her on the cheek. Her conduct constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01C(1).
4. **WINES** admits the allegations referenced in paragraphs 2 and 3 above.
5. On March 20, 2004, the **BOARD** proposed to issue an order suspend, revoke, or take other disciplinary action with regard to the social work license of **WINES**. Additional reasons for the proposed order included the following:

In the summer of 2002, while **WINES** was employed as a social work associate at the Veteran's Administration, Columbus, Ohio, she blurred her professional boundaries by going on a canoe trip with a client. Her conduct constitutes a violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 4757.36(A)(1) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4757-5-01C(1).

6. While **WINES** does not admit the allegation referenced in paragraph 5, she understands that the terms and conditions incorporated into this agreement are based upon the all of allegations referenced in paragraphs 2, 3 and 5, above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, **WINES** knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the **BOARD** to the following terms and conditions:

1. **WINES'** license to practice social work is SUSPENDED for three (3) months beginning August 1, 2004, through October 31 2004.
2. **WINES** must take and pass a social work ethics course. The

course must be taken for credit, part of a social work program from an accredited university, and pre-approved by the **BOARD**. Once **WINES** successfully completes this course, **WINES** must ensure official transcripts are sent directly from the university to the attention of the Investigation Unit at the Board office. The transcript verifying completion is due in the Board office no later than December 31, 2005. The credit earned from the course may not be used toward the thirty (30) hours of continuing education required for license renewal. All costs associated with the course are at the expense of **WINES**.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this CONSENT AGREEMENT hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.


By her signature on this CONSENT AGREEMENT, **WINES** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this CONSENT AGREEMENT, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **WINES** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this CONSENT AGREEMENT and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this CONSENT AGREEMENT or of any information relating thereto.

**WINES** hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.


This CONSENT AGREEMENT shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code 3123.41 et seq. the **BOARD** may be required to provide **WINES'** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this CONSENT AGREEMENT into a formal journal entry at its July 16, 2004, meeting.


This Consent Agreement will become effective on the date signed by the Chair of the Board.


