**CONSENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SANDRA L. LANG
AND THE
STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND
FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD**

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into by and between SANDRA L. LANG, hereinafter, "LANG," and the STATE OF OHIO COUNSELOR, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BOARD, hereinafter "BOARD," the state agency charged with enforcing Chapter 4757 of the Ohio Revised Code and all rules promulgated therein.

LANG hereby acknowledges that she has read and understands this CONSENT AGREEMENT and has voluntarily entered into it without threat or promise by the BOARD or any of its members, employees or agents.

LANG is fully aware of her rights, including her right to be advised by counsel and her right to a hearing pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code on the issues which are the subject of this CONSENT AGREEMENT. Should LANG fail to comply with any provisions of this CONSENT AGREEMENT, LANG knowingly waives her rights under ORC Chapter 119.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT contains the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies the terms of this CONSENT AGREEMENT.

This CONSENT AGREEMENT is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions and understandings:

1. LANG applied for licensure as a licensed social worker with the BOARD on June 25, 2004.
2. During the course of the BOARD'S licensure application review process, the BOARD determined that LANG had been practicing social work without a license in Rogers, Ohio, from September 2003 until January 2004.
3. LANG ADMITS the allegations referenced in paragraph 2 above.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal disciplinary proceedings, LANG knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the BOARD to the following terms and conditions:

1. The **BOARD** will license **LANG** as a licensed social worker at its September 17, 2004, meeting.
2. **LANG** is required to take an additional five (5) hours of continuing education in the area of social work ethics in her first renewal period. Both the required thirty hours and the additional five hours must be pre-approved by the **BOARD**. **LANG** must present certifications of attendance showing completion of all thirty-five hours by September 17, 2006. Once all required hours have been completed, **LANG** will forward copies of her attendance certificates to the **BOARD'S** Deputy Director.

It is hereby agreed by and between both parties that this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** hereby settles all issues concerning this matter.

By her signature on this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, **LANG** acknowledges that in the event the **BOARD**, in its discretion, does not approve this **CONSENT AGREEMENT**, this settlement offer is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon or introduced in any disciplinary action or appeal by either party. **LANG** agrees that should the **BOARD** reject this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** and if this case proceeds to hearing, she will assert no claim that the **BOARD** was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** or of any information relating thereto.

LANG hereby releases the members of the **BOARD**, its officers and employees, jointly and severally, from any and all liability arising from the matter within.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall be considered a public record as that term is used in Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code. Pursuant to 42 USC Section 132a-73(b), 5 USC Section 552a, 45 CFR part 61, and Ohio Revised Code Section 3123.41 et seq. the **BOARD** may be required to provide **LANG'S** social security number to requesting governmental agencies.

The **BOARD** shall incorporate this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** into a formal journal entry at its September 17, 2004, meeting.

This **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall take effect upon the date of the Board Chair's signature below:
